Dear Roslyn,

I was pleased to learn that you have managed to establish most of your cultures successfully. It was a pity that the blood typing was not more complete: apart from a full Rh phenotyping the presence of A₂ in the ABO system is also diagnostic of white admixture. However, the absence of any large S+ and Rh- individuals is encouraging. We have completed tests on seven systems so far and again there is nothing to indicate that the samples you collected were not from full-blood Aborigines. There are still a few more tests to complete and I hope to be able to let you have the results within the next week or two.

I will look forward to having a more detailed report on the chromosome results when your analysis is more complete.
