Giese outlined projects which the Social Welfare Branch is currently involved in & those he would like to see developed further

1. Social Circumstances Survey

— jointly with Adelaide & ARU. Teedes, Gibb & Perkins?

An attempt to find causes for high infant mortality & morbidity 2 years at Yunderum

2. Demographic & social characteristics Survey  
Milliken's work being put on cards for computer analysis - Adelaide (Ovensen?)

3. Traditional occupational Survey - Ceramic expert being brought out in conjunction with Uni of A.S.W.

Would like to see proper growth study with emphasis on somatotyping. Believes there are significant differences in body build between groups, & any nutritional assessment must take account of this.
